We're reopening the canteen on Sundays on March 19th, Noon to 8 PM.

- We will begin having hot food on Friday nights: just bar snacks like Jalapeño poppers, breaded cheese curds, cheese stuffed pretzels, French fries.

- There's now a TV at the north end of the bar
