We have several unfilled offices within our Post: Community Service, Membership, and Poppies. Please contact me. PACT ACT REGISTRATION DEADLINE: AUGUST 9TH. The one-year deadline to sign up is fast approaching: August 9th! Vets who file for benefits after the deadline will not be eligible to receive retroactive payment for this past year. DO YOU HAVE IT? As a veteran, one of the most important documents you need to have is your Certificate of Release or Discharge From Active Duty, commonly called, simply, "DD214." It certifies your eligibility for VFW membership, opens many doors at the VA, authorizes veteran license tags, etc. Equally important is that your family will want to have it someday: To know more about your history; To help you claim medical benefits; To bury you with

If this applies to you, you need to change that right away. This is easy to ignore, but believe me that a time will come when your family will want or need it.
